A. CDBG Grant – 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Project

Discussion Only: Randy Shaffer with WTC engineers presented three design options for the council to consider for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Street project to be completed with the funds awarded from the Community Development Block Grant. WTC plans to redo the entirety of 3<sup>rd</sup> street with this grant from Commerce Street all the way to Ross Street. Their goal is to help direct the flow of storm water, so the intersections are not flooded each time it rains. Mr. Shaffer would like some guidance from the council about how they would like to see the right-of-way (ROW) on Ross addressed since it is an unpaved section of 3<sup>rd</sup>. Option one would be to install Rip-Rap structure to help direction the flow of water, option two would include the same rip-rap and installation of valley gutters, and the third would be to pave that portion of 3<sup>rd</sup> street down to the river bed with the valley gutters and rip-rap. All three options would exceed the amount for the grant and the city would have to provide the funds. The council expressed their desire for a fourth design that would incorporate all three, but not pave the street past the last house on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street since the ROW is barely traveled. They also would like to see if they can contact any volunteers to bring the overgrown ROW back down to grade to cut off some of the cost of the grant.

B. Appointing Tax Assessor for 2024.

Motion by Council Member Brantly Robertson to appoint Gina Williams at the City of Robert Lee Tax Assessor for 2024. Seconded by Council Member Skyler Rainwater. Vote 5-0, motion carried.

C. 17-24 – Municipal Court Ordinance – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading

Motion by Mayor Pro Tem Mike Stephens to approve of the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of 17-24, Municipal Court Ordinance. Seconded by Council Member Josh Tennison. Vote 5-0, motion carried.




